SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

PHOTOS: We require 3 to 5 color prints of your fallen hero, which will be returned to you with the completed portrait. Head and face images are especially important. Bear in mind that the quality of the finished portrait depends greatly on the quality of the photos you send to us, which serve as the reference for our artists.

One of our five brilliant, professional Portrait Compassion artists will create the portrait, which may or may not be founding artist Kaziah Hancock. This is for equal distribution of the work, and to prevent any one artist from an unfair proportion of requests. We cannot accept special requests as to how the portrait should be painted, for specific artists to create the portrait, or for duplicate portraits as Project Compassion is funded for only one portrait per family. If there are multiple family members interested in a Project Compassion portrait, it is upto the family to determine who should be the recipient of the original painting, and to contact local professional photography studios for information on duplicates, prints, etc. Due to the current volume of portrait requests, you may expect to receive your completed, framed portrait approximately 6 months from the date we receive your material. We also respectfully ask that you do not contact Project Compassion for a status on the progress of your portrait; such calls cannot be returned.
